- 7) Vertical grade control will be to plus or minus 0.10 feet, compaction to 90%.
- 8) All layout and staking shall be performed by a Land Surveyor or Civil Engineer licensed in the State of California. Job is to be certified by engineers immediately upon completion.
- 9) Additional costs for 40 hour trained personnel.
