The real estate market in April saw a notable increase in the number of price reductions in multiple listing services, along with significant reductions in those rates. ## **REFLECTION**

Interestingly, while the overall number of listings is up, the number of sublease listings has slightly decreased. This indicates ongoing downward pressure on rents, creating a tenant-favorable market in the near term. Consequently, landlords might be more inclined to negotiate lease transactions now, anticipating further weakening in lease rates.

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
